# OUR GROUP TOURS

## DUBLIN CITY TOUR

One of the best places for exploring history and characters. So much crammed into such a small city! An array of things to see and discuss, we include Parnell, O'Connell, 1916, the famine and even apartheid. Lots of art and culture – from James Joyce to U2 & The Beatles. ## BOYNE VALLEY TOUR

See 3 famous Irish sites in one half day! Monasterboice, home to Ireland's tallest high cross, The Battle of The Boyne Visitor Centre where we discuss what really happened here and the consequences. We walk amongst the ruins of the magnificent Mellifont Abbey steeped in history and legend. A fantastic day out!



## LAYTOWN, COASTAL TOUR

From Viking invasions to holiday camps to Hollywood movies, the beautiful seaside town of Laytown has seen its fair share of action! We take our guests on a walk along the picturesque strand, telling the diverse history of this fascinating area.

## MOUNTAIN FARM WITH SHEEPDOG TRIALS

Fantastic experience for students to visit a real working farm. The Farm has Cows, Sheep, Goats and even a Llama (which students can feed). Highlight is the sheepdogs trials. You get up close to see the amazing sheepdogs round up the sheep. Games are also available to entertain the students after they've enjoyed the educational experience. There is a tuck shop on site and students can have their lunch relaxing on benches in the farm grounds.



## DROGHEDA GATED TOWN TOUR

A fascinating walk through the streets of Drogheda exploring its troubled history and colourful characters. From St Oliver Plunkett to the infamous Oliver Cromwell. From the invention of submarines to the historic walls and gates of Drogheda. There are stories of public hangings, attacks, diseases, the river Boyne and the town's great sporting achievements. All mixed with a celebration of art & culture. A wonderful town to explore.



## CLOGHERHEAD COASTAL HIKE

Breathtaking views as we take a guided hike along the amazing Clogherhead. Clogherhead means 'Rocky Headland' and you will see why. The cliffs mark where the island of Ireland was once physically split by the 'Iapetus Suture'. It is where, some 5,000 years ago, rocks were taken to be used to build the famous Newgrange burial mound. Hear about the beautiful harbour, local characters and fascinating stories of our East coast.
